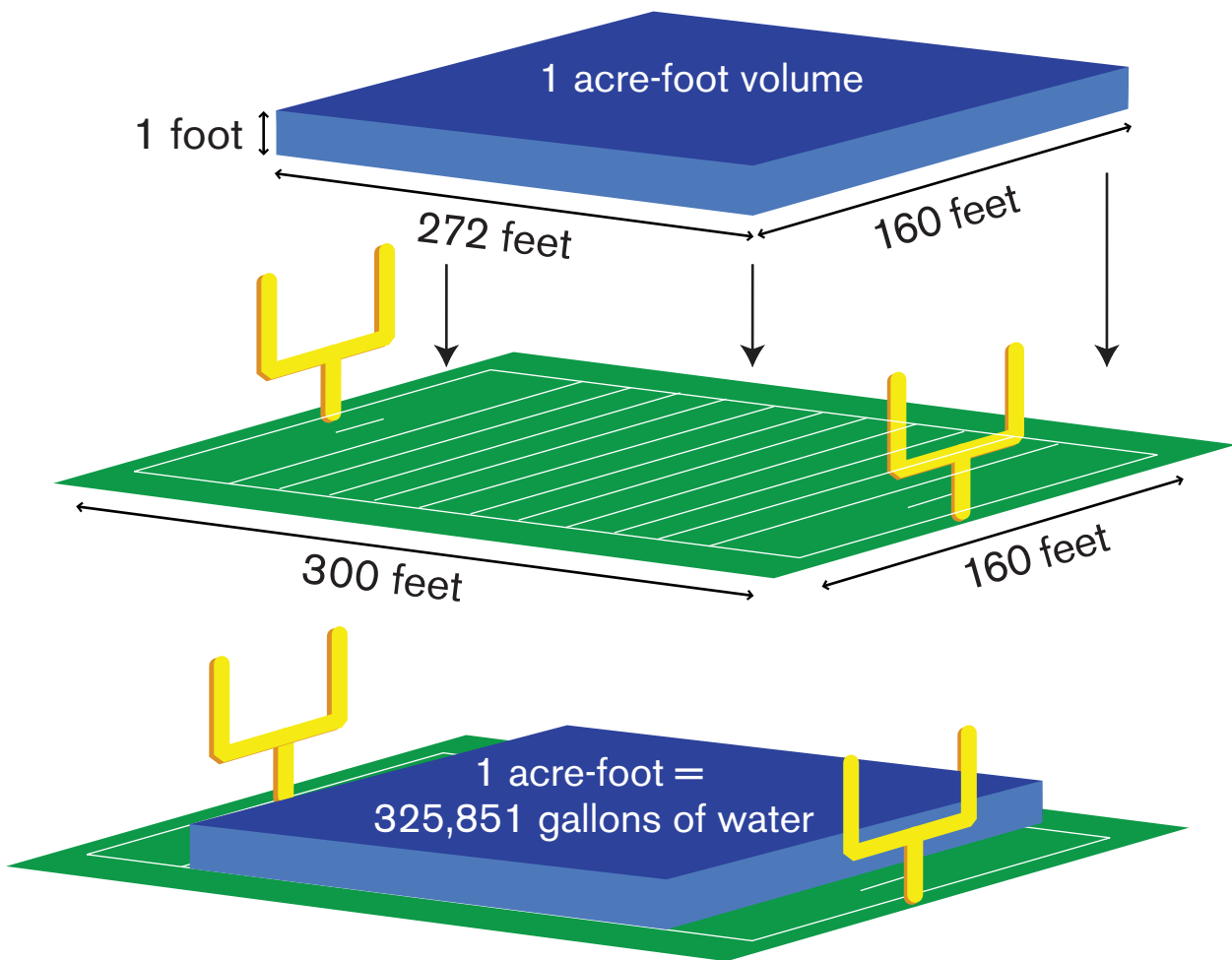


What is an acre-foot?



An acre-foot is the amount of water it would take to flood an acre to a depth of one foot. A football field is just a little larger than an acre. If you were standing on the 50-yard line of this football field, you would be surrounded by an acre-foot of water.
