Tips for The Kitchen

1. Clean as you go
2. Make sure smoke detectors are installed in every room, and check batteries regularly
3. Avoid wearing loose clothing while cooking, because it can catch on fire
4. Point pot handles away from the edge of the stove
5. Never leave cooking food unattended
6. Wipe off any spilled grease from the stove
7. Make sure there is proper lighting in the area you are working in
8. Avoid using appliances with frayed cords

Tips for Personal Safety

1. Never open a door to a stranger
2. Never leave your purse unattended
3. Tear or shred all personal or financial information - never just throw it away
4. Have your key(s) ready to go - do not fumble looking in a bag or purse
5. At home, never tell people you are alone
6. In cars, never leave anything valuable in plain sight
7. Have deadbolts installed on your door, if possible
