ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES
FINANCIAL: WASTE AND RECYCLE BIN REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT POLICY

PURPOSE:

This policy will provide direction and guidance on how funds are to be used for maintenance and repair of waste bins owned by residential customers within Castle Hills.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

On October 1, 2017 Community Waste Disposal (“CWD”) took over both waste and recycle service for all residential customer in Castle Hills. CWD, at their cost, provided new, larger recycle bins for every single-family home to use at no charge to the resident. At the end of their 5-year contract, the recycle bins are the property of CWD.

The waste bins are owned by each residence and it is the resident’s responsibility to repair or replace the waste bin. New home buyers purchase a new or “nearly new” reconditioned waste bin with the CWD logo on the side of the bin. The waste bins that are purchased by the resident may be “passed on” in the event the home is re-sold to a new resident within Castle Hills.

Many residents have owned their waste bins for as long as 10 years and possibly longer. As such, some may need repair or replacement.

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR:

In the contract with CWD, they agree to repair lids and wheels, which are generally the “parts” that need repair most often. If more repairs, beyond lids and wheels are needed, it is best to just replace the bin. In our agreement with CWD, the District will pay for the parts and CWD will provide the “labor” to repair the bins.

The District shall charge a flat fee of \$25.00 to replace the lid and \$25.00 to replace the wheels.
